Re: 1st Notice of Intent to Sue for Violations of RCW 42.17A

Dear elected officials:

We represent Washingtonians for Ethical Government (“Washingtonians”) in submitting this statutory notice of intent to sue.

Washingtonians have reason to believe that Tim Eyman, Jack Fagan, Mike Fagan, Barbara Smith, and We Love Our Cars – VMWC – 2017 (collectively “Eyman”) have violated RCW chapter 42.17A.

Washingtonians intend to bring a citizens’ action against Eyman under RCW 42.17A.765(4) if you do not commence an action against Eyman within the following notice periods specified by statute. At the expiration of 45 days from the date of this letter, a second notice of intent to sue will be sent to you if you have not yet filed suit against Eyman. If after 10 days following receipt of the second notice you still have not filed suit against Eyman, Washingtonians will bring an action in Superior Court.

I. Violations of RCW 42.17A.

The basis for Washingtonians’ belief that Eyman violated certain sections of RCW Chapter 42.17A is described in the attached complaint form and incorporated herein by reference. Indisputable evidence shows Eyman intentionally violated our campaign laws.

II. Tim Eyman is a Serial Violator of RCW 42.17A.

Eyman’s latest violations are part of a long history of Tim Eyman’s disregard for our state’s campaign finance laws. Eyman already has three strikes against him, and the current violations are the fifth. He should not be given another pass.

Strike One: In 2002, Eyman was required to pay \$50,000 in penalties and was barred from serving as a treasurer or having control over a political committee's financial accounts, based upon evidence tending to show that Eyman deceived contributors, embezzled funds from his campaign organization, and failed to properly report the committee's expenditures. For specific evidence and details, see PDC Case No. 02-281.

Strike Two: In 20004, fines were assessed against three of Tim Eyman's political committees. *See* PDC Case No. 05-066 and 05-068.

Strike Three: Not long ago, the PDC found again that Eyman used campaign funds for personal use and illegally used funds raised for one initiative to support a different initiative. The PDC found evidence of illegal concealment because the "expenditures were described in the committee's report as paying for I-1185 signatures, but were intended in part to result in compensation for Mr. Eyman." The PDC found multiple violations of the law and the matter is currently being prosecuted by the Attorney General.

Strike Four: In May, we sent a 45-day notice letter to you which outlined additional violations. Based upon that notice, the PDC recommended that the Attorney General bring another lawsuit against Eyman for multiple apparent violations of RCW 42.17A.205, RCW 42.17A.240, and RCW 42.17A.320. An investigation by PDC staff found that the Eyman-controlled committee Bring Back Our \$30 Car Tabs failed to report an independent expenditure opposing candidates for the Washington State Legislature in a complete and timely manner, failed to amend the committee's registration with updated information as the law requires, and failed to provide complete and accurate sponsor identification and list of top five contributors in its advertising. *See* PDC Case No. 5729.

Tim Eyman has again and again shown a complete and utter disregard for our campaign finance laws and must be prosecuted to the full extent of the law.

III. Penalty Demand.


All of the persons and entities described in this letter should pay a penalty for their part in this concealment.

Washingtonians intend to sue for all violations, including those yet to be uncovered and those committed subsequent to the date of this notice of intent to sue. Washingtonians believe that this Notice sufficiently states grounds for filing suit. We intend, at the close of the notice periods, or shortly thereafter, to file a citizen's action against the above-named persons and entities under RCW 42.17A.765(4) for violations of the Fair Campaign Practices Act, RCW Chapter 42.17A. II. Alleged Violations

On June 1st, 2016, Respondent officers formed a political committee called “We Love Our Cars – VMWC – 2017” (hereafter WLOC), a ballot committee with the stated purpose of supporting Initiative 869, an initiative to the 2017 Washington State Legislature (see Exhibit A). On July 11th, 2016, Respondents filed the committee’s first C4 and C3 reports; an amended C4 was subsequently filed on July 13th, 2016.

The amended C4 filed on July 13th, 2016 (see Exhibit B) states that the committee had previous total cash and in kind contributions of \$143,947.61, and received \$6,274.38 in cash for the month of June, for a total of \$150,221,99. No in kind contributions, loans, or pledges were reported.

However, this amended C4 was the very first C4 filed by the campaign – it could not have had any previous cash or in-kind contributions because it had only just been formed.

WLOC has reported raising a total of \$154,854.71 to date. The vast majority of this sum – \$143,947.61, or ninety-two percent of the total – is unaccounted for. The law requires that committees report *all* of their contributions so that the public can **follow the money**. By concealing the source of WLOC's seed money, which constitutes over ninety percent of the total raised since its formation, WLOC and its officers are committing an egregious act of concealment. Months have transpired since the filing of the aforementioned reports, but Respondents have not disclosed where the \$143,947.61 came from. Respondents have failed to comply with the reporting requirements of Chapter 42.17A RCW, and must be held accountable.
